1) Cash Bash

- a. Design & information to be included on the tickets was finalized. Rick will have the tickets printed (200 for the raffle, \$100 tickets, and 200 for the party, \$25 tickets) and ready for distribution & sale prior to Festival on the Green.

2) Festival on the Green

- a. Greg has reserved two areas for us; one for baseball throwing and one for table to sell tickets and display other information regarding Village Parks.
- b. Greg has made contact with HFL HS (Christine Gephardt) to see if there is a student(s) that would be willing to create a 5-10 minute DVD for us. Confirmation of whether or not this is possible is anticipated this week.
- c. Cash Bash tickets will be ready to be sold during the Festival design.
- d. John Moffett has indicated that the radar gun and baseball target that HFM Baseball League is available for our use. He is also checking on the availability of the booth.
- e. Mary will create a large poster advertising Cash Bash based upon the design of the raffle tickets.
- f. Volunteer schedule for Baseball Throw and Village table needs to be developed.

3) Golf Tournament

- a. Wally Dyer, of Dyer Straits, was in attendance to discuss "Closest to the Pin" Tournament.
- b. Identified dates of the tournament: Saturday August 1, Saturday August 8 and Sunday August 9.
- c. John and Jerry will develop the structure of the tournament. Awards will be made in 3 divisions: Youth (under 14), Women and Men
- d. Prizes need to be gathered.

- 4) Monroe Street Park
  - a. Greg will be meeting with the “Skate Skool”, a skateboarding club, on Wednesday June 3 at 2:30 pm at the Park. Anyone from the committee is welcome to join him!
  - b. Additional concrete will be poured to expand the existing pad creating a 105’ x 62’ area for skateboarding.
  
- 5) North Main Street-HFM Rotary Park
  - a. The area from the parking lot to the pavilion has been mulched along with the gardens. Additional planting has been completed in the gardens as well.
  - b. It is anticipated that the Eagle Project that involves the installation of a new flag pole and electricity to the bathrooms will be completed by the end of June.
